

### Brush roller operation ATTENTION

Risk of damage to the floor covering.

- Do not operate the appliance on the spot.

  A Set the pile height via the adjustment known and the spot.
- A Set the pile height via the adjustment knob of the brush head.
  - Push the unlocking mechanism of the brush head and tilt the handle backwards.

    Brush motor switches on.

    Perform the cleaning operation.
- The electronic brush control continuously monitors the work of the brush roller.

### No light

Brush roller is working properly.

#### Orange light is glowing

Set the adjustment knob for pile height to the lower pile height.

Orange light also glows at lowest level Replace the brush roller.


### Suction pipe operation ATTENTION

When you vacuum with the suction hose, the device must lock into place in the home position in order to allow the brush motor to switch off

- A Bring the handle in a vertical position and snap it into place on the brush head.
- B Pull the suction pipe out toward the top.
  - Perform the cleaning operation.
